


1. Go to <http://maps.google.com>
2. Search for your property by address (or city if no street address) and select the “satellite” or aerial version of the map.
3. Drag or pan the map until your property is shown from above.
4. Click on “Link” in the upper right hand side to produce the weblink that can be emailed.
5. Copy the link text and paste into the field on the Speedy property form.
